

- 1) (5 points) What do we mean by intelligence? What qualities can be used to describe intelligence and how can they be measured or verified? Describe different means by which intelligence is acquired?
- 2) (4 points) Describe whether or not it is possible to use the specified technique to construct a classifier for each of the following problems. If it IS possible, explain how to train and compute a model for  $P(\omega_{\nu} \mid \vec{X})$ . If it is not possible, explain why.
  - a) You have a training set composed of grades from 2 subjects for a population of 100 students from each of 20 countries. Can you use a K-nearest neighbor classifier to determine most likely nationality of a student from their grades?
  - b) You have a training set composed of the weight (kg), height (cm), age (y) and gender for a population of 100 people. Can you use a Kernel density estimator to determine most likely gender for an unknown person from their weight (kg), height (cm) and age (y)?
- 4) (6 points) You are presented with a single neuron with two inputs  $(X_1, X_2)$  and a single output a computed using a sigmoid  $(f(z) = \frac{1}{1 + e^{-z}})$ . Your network has been initialized with weights  $W_1 = -0.2$  and  $W_2 = +0.1$  and b = +0.1. Assume a learning rate of  $\eta = 0.1$ .



Your network should be trained to recognize the following training data:

m	$x_1$	$x_2$	Уm
1	1	0	1
2	0	1	1
3	0	0	1
4	1	1	0

- a) Compute z, and a for m=1.
- b) Compute  $\delta_m^{(2)} = h(X_m) y_m$  for m = 1c) Compute  $\delta_m^{(1)}$  for m = 1
- d) Compute  $\Delta W_1$ ,  $\Delta W_2$ , and  $\Delta b$  for m=1
- e) Update  $W_1$ ,  $W_2$ , and b for m=1.
- f) Will your neuron converge for this training data?
- 5) (5 points) Given the following deftemplates in CLIPS:

(deftemplate product (slot NAME)(slot KIND)(slot PRICE))

Write a rule in CLIPS that will select and print the name and price of the least expensive product for a each kind of product.
